



Update!!

In light of the current Corona Virus/Covid 19 crisis, Aurelia Training Ltd continues to be open for business.

Aurelia are continuing to deliver training and inductions on a remote basis, with consideration of social distancing regulations and can continue to work with Furloughed learners.

'Remote learning ' refers to learning which takes place when face to face workshops are not available in the workplace or training venue.

Remote learning will take place when:

- Due to current Covid19 related reasons a learner needs to self-isolate.
- The workplace or training venue is asked to close or restrict attendance as part of a local or national lockdown.

As a part of our remote learning offer to all Learners we will provide:

- continued setting of work for all qualifications being undertaken.
- access to training staff to discuss progress and support, through email and telephone contact with additional support provided for those who need it.
- planned on-line learning will take place through established timetabled sessions and where necessary flexible sessions provided to meet individual learner need.
- alternative assessment arrangements will be made available in line with Awarding Body and End Point Assessment Organisation guidance.

It is expected that learners will continue to maintain contact with their trainer and where possible attend scheduled sessions, and complete all work set by reasonable deadlines. Where circumstances make this difficult continued communication will enable alternative strategies to be put in place. Any student who is lacking the IT resources to complete this 'remote learning' should contact their trainer to discuss alternative arrangements where possible.

We are currently developing a learning platform to provide an additional resource for use by learners unable to attend face to face sessions. This is currently available for remote inductions and resources for all sectors which will continue to be developed to support face to face and online learning.
