Cleaning Hygiene Operative L2

Who is this for?

This occupation is found in a wide range of workplaces where specialised cleaning techniques and skills are needed to maintain a safe and hygienic environment. Cleaning hygiene operative will work both independently and as part of a team. They will report to a cleaning supervisor or service leader. They will work both during normal working hours and outside of normal working hours, depending on the environment they are in. They may also need to provide services immediately throughout the day. Healthcare cleaning and hygiene operatives work in places where infection control and sanitation are important for the wellbeing of service users. They may work in hospitals, care homes, doctors, dentists, and health care settings within prisons.

Commercial cleaning and hygiene operatives work in environments where people mix and that must be thoroughly cleaned to ensure they are always safe and hygienic. This could include environments with heavy footfall. These environments need high levels of hygiene and cleanliness to prevent the growth and spread of micro-organisms and bacteria. Places that a commercial cleaning operative may work in include food and delivery premises, hotels and accommodation, shopping centres, offices, public transport and stations, public spaces, factories, education buildings, leisure facilities and government buildings.

Diploma

There is a diploma that can be added into the award if the employer and learner wish for this.

Functional skills English and Math's

If the learner does not have English and Math's Qualifications GCSE or equivalent at grade C & above, then to complete the course they will work with a qualified functional skills tutor to complete the qualifications required.

End Point Assessment

During the course, the learner will be working towards the knowledge, skills and behaviours to go to gateway. This comprises of an examination of 30 questions and an observation as well as a professional discussion underpinned by a portfolio of evidence.

Programme Duration

This apprenticeship is a 12-month course with a further 3 months for the EPA.
