## Early Intervention Practitioner Level 4

### Who is this for?

This occupation is found in statutory and voluntary organisations who can provide person centred, early intervention approaches and services to support individuals across all age ranges from pre birth to end of life. Early Intervention Practitioners offer practical help and emotional support to individuals experiencing a range of problems to help them overcome concerns or barriers impacting daily life, such as alcohol, drugs, gambling misuse, behaviours issues, mobility issues and learning difficulties.

Early Intervention Practitioners provide impartial information, advice, support and guidance to individuals and others impacted by the individuals' circumstances such as family and friends. They will source the right intervention and identify the risks that could occur.

### Diploma

There is no diploma with this award.

### Functional skills English and Math's

If the learner does not have English and Math's Qualifications GCSE or equivalent at grade C & above, then to complete the course they will work with a qualified functional skills tutor to complete the qualifications required.

### End Point Assessment

During the course, the learner will be working towards the knowledge, skills and behaviours to go to gateway.

Once the Diploma and functional skills have been achieved and the employer feels that the learner is ready then End Point Assessment can take place.

This involves a portfolio of evidence and a professional discussion, a work-based case study and questioning.

### Programme Duration

This apprenticeship is a 18-month course with a further 3 months for the EPA.
