Who is it for?

Supply Chain Operators are primarily responsible for managing the movement of goods for a variety of customers across all sectors, and as such their customer base will range from large global organisations to sole traders and private customers in local areas, depending on their organisation. They will work in one or more of a variety of subsectors, including: shipping, removals, import/export, freight, hazardous goods, and food. Work roles might include, Traffic or Transport Officer, and Removals Operative.

About the Course

The standards for Supply Chain Operator were developed by the trailblazer employer group, made up of around 50 different employers in this sector. The same group produced a list of learning outcomes which represent the higher order skills and knowledge that should be assessed at end point assessment stage. It is these learning outcomes which must be achieved in order for the apprentice to be deemed a competent Supply Chain Operator. Essential core knowledge, skills and behaviours for Supply Chain Operators are required to be developed throughout, and demonstrated on completion of their apprenticeship.

Functional skills English and Math's – If the learner does not have English and Math's Qualifications GCSE or equivalent at grade C & above, then to complete the course they will work with a qualified functional skills tutor to complete the qualifications required.

End Point Assessment - During the course, the learner will be working towards the knowledge, skills and behaviours to go to gateway. These compromise of a Knowledge & Behaviours test and a Practical Assessment.

The programme includes:

- Unlimited support and guidance from a qualified trainer via phone and email
- All programme documentation, files and materials
- One to one portfolio review session
- Regular workshops held in the workplace at pre-agreed dates and times
